

## **Marina Goshkueva, pianist**

### *Curriculum Vitae*

Marina Goshkueva was born in 1982 in Saint Petersburg. From 1998 until 2002 she studied in the Rimsky-Korsakov College in the class from Prof. Eleonora Grudinova. Since 2002 she had lessons with Prof. Tatiana Zagorovskaya in the St. Petersburg Music Conservatory. From 2004 until 2008 she studied in the Franz Liszt Music Academy in Weimar and had classes with Prof. Arne Torger. After completing these studies she obtained an artistic diploma. Then she studied for one further year with Prof. Rolf-Dieter Arens in a specialization course. Since October 2009 she studies in the Music Academy in Stuttgart in the class of Prof. Kirill Gerstein.

Marina participated also in several masterclasses such as Prof. Ferenc Rados (Hungary), Prof. Paul-Badura Skoda (Austria), Prof. Peter Nagy (Hungary), Prof. Andrei Jasinski (Poland), Bernard Ringeissen (France), Prof. Homero Francesch (Switzerland). She had success on different piano competitions as the first prize in the Youth International Chopin Piano Competition in Narva (2000), the first prize in the Yudina International Chamber Music Competition in St. Petersburg (2002), first prize in the Gartow Stiftung Competition in St. Petersburg (2003), second prize in the Lions-Club Competition in Kassel (2006), second prize in the 14<sup>th</sup> Maria Campina Piano Competition in Faro, Portugal (2008) and second prize in the 7<sup>th</sup> Vila de Capdepera International Piano Competition (2008). In April 2009 she became a Culture Prize from the Lions-Club Würzburg, Leone. (Germany). Marina performs often recitals in Germany, Austria and Russia.
